Task groups 2023 (status of work)

<u>Task group 2:</u> Coating quality

Head: Marc Schnau, x-plan schnau engineering

Vice-President Marc Schnau reported that Technical Information No. 6 " Pipe casing and coating in HDD" has been completed in German. In the course of editing, a risk assessment was also created in an Excel spreadsheet, which enables an individual project-related consideration. Technical Information No. 6 will be sent to all members with the next Member Info after Easter.

<u>Task group 3:</u> Revision of the Technical Guidelines Head: Ernst Fengler, LMR Drilling GmbH

Task group 3, which deals with the revision of the Technical Guidelines, will be finished soon. The draft of the 5th edition of the Technical Guideline should be completed by the middle of the year and submitted to the members for review. As soon as the draft is available here, it will be distributed via member information.

<u>Task group 4:</u> Data acquisition and logging

In task group 4 "Data aquisition and logging", chaired by board member Scott Stone four stages of data collection were defined. The next steps will involve exchanges with equipment manufacturers and vendors, including how recorded data can be stored and viewed in real time or after the fact.

Task group 5: Subsoil

Task group 5 "Subsoil" is new and is chaired by Phillipp Dick from Moll prd. The task group was set up together with the GSTT (Germany) and will deal with various questions relating to the ever new topic of "HDD and subsoil". Details were determined at the kick off meeting of the task group at the beginning of April.

DVGW task group GW 340 (Germany):

Preparation of a new DIN for the quality assurance of works coatings

Board member Jörg Himmerich reported on the DCA's participation in the DVGW task group GW 340, which deals with the protection applied in addition to the anti-corrosion coating as mechanical protection of steel pipes and fittings - the quality assurance of factory coatings. The yellow print for DIN 30340 - Part 1 is available, the white print is expected in the middle of the 2nd quarter 2023. A second and possibly a third part are to follow.

DCA sponsorship programme

Board member Jörg Himmerich provided information on the DCA sponsorship programme HDD-Technic, in the course of which Johannes Rotter subsequently presented his bachelor thesis on the topic of "Noise emissions on HDD construction sites". The thesis explained the topic of sound propagation, its influencing factors and possible measures to reduce noise emissions. New topics for the sponsorship programme are being sought for 2024. Please contact project coordinator Jörg Himmerich.

Reports of the representatives

The DCA now has five representatives who support the work of the association in Europe. These include Renzo Chirulli, Vermeer, for Italy, Brian Jorgensen, Ditch Witch EMEA, for the Iberian Peninsula, Scott Stone, Michels Trenchless GmbH, for the UK, Ireland, François Gandard, OPTIMUM for France and Benny Jensen, Dantonit A/S for Scandinavia. At the members' meeting, all representatives gave an overview of the state of the HDD industry in each country. In addition, potential new members who are interested in joining the DCA were introduced. If you are interested in becoming a representative, please contact the office.

Membership figures

Since the members' meeting in 2022, a total of 21 new companies have been admitted to the DCA. By mid-March 2023, 155 members were organized in the DCA. Of these, 63 are registered as regular members (HDD drilling companies) and 92 as associate members.
