Bamberg

With its approx. 2,400 half-timbered houses, the old town of Bamberg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is one of the largest largely intact historic town centres in Germany and is an outstanding and representative example of an early medieval town in Central Europe. Well-known sights include the old town hall, the 'Little Venice' neighbourhood and the Domberg with the old court, the new residence and the four-towered Bamberg Cathedral, one of the former imperial cathedrals. Bamberg is also known nationwide for its diverse beer tradition. Today there are still 8 breweries in the old town centre.

On the **first day** of the congress, a guided tour of the impressive city of Bamberg is on the programme. Let yourself be enchanted by the medieval old town in its baroque guise. Afterwards, you can enjoy a drink in one of Bamberg's oldest breweries.

On Thursday, the **second day** of the congress, the spouse tour invites the participants to take a trip to Franconian Switzerland. The programme includes a visit to a traditional fruit farm with a distillery and an exploration of the largest stalactite cave in the region. The **third day** of the congress can be spent at leisure.
